Speaker DeVillier moved approval of the minutes of the July 16, 2026 meeting, seconded by Senator Mizell, and without objection, the minutes were approved.

Ms. Folse provided a synopsis on Items 3 through 10, Local Governmental Units - Elections (December 12, 2026). Speaker DeVillier moved approval, seconded by Senator Mizell, and without objection, Items 3 through 10 were approved.

Ms. Folse provided a synopsis on Item 11, St. Mary Parish, City of Franklin. Speaker DeVillier moved approval, seconded by Senator Mizell, and without objection, Item 11 was approved.

Ms. Folse provided a synopsis on Item 12, Sabine Parish, Fire Protection District No. 1, Wards 1 and 2.
